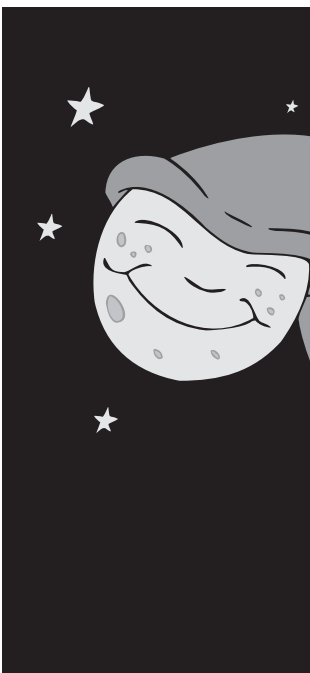

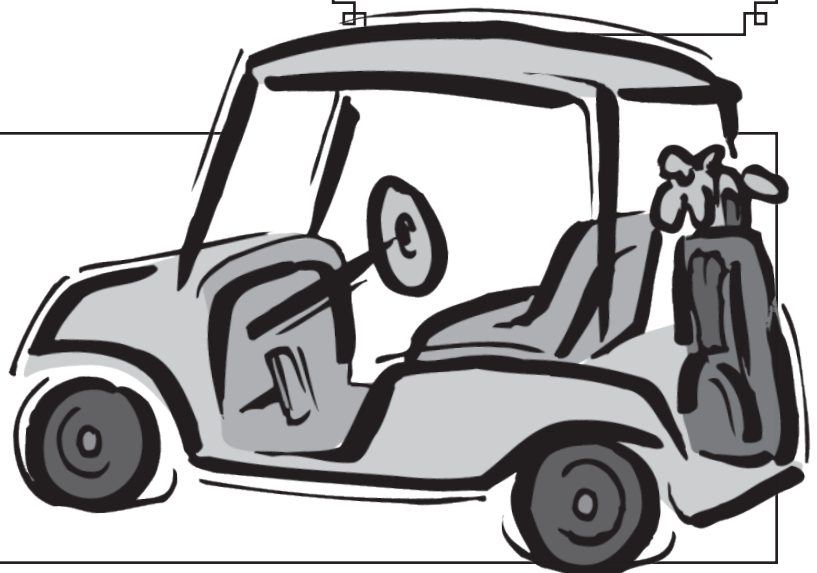

SCATTER:

- S:** Seek alternate path than that of the other golf carts before you.
- C:** Costs no more to blaze a new trail.
- A:** Awareness of your surroundings will help you to avoid repair areas and high traffic areas.
- T:** Think about how much it costs(your money) to repair areas damaged by golf carts and the months of recovery.
- T:** Try avoiding driving along ropes, stakes, signs, and other types of barriers meant to keep you from driving through newly repaired areas and other high traffic areas.
- E:** Everyone (members) has the responsibility for keeping cart traffic damage to a minimum. We can spend the money making improvements or we can spend the money making repairs, or barriers.
- R:** Remember, Only you can prevent cart trails. Be a leader, don't follow the other carts.
