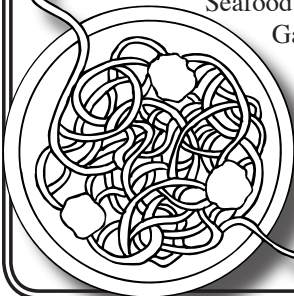

News from the PRO SHOP

This month I want to talk a little bit about club fitting and its importance to your golf game. Ill fitting clubs can cause a golfer to hook, slice, push or pull a shot. By having the correct fit for your golf swing you might find that you hit the ball straighter and maybe even further. It really doesn't matter what manufacturer you choose, in today's high tech world it's hard to find a poor piece of equipment. If you stick to the major golf companies your chances are very good that it will be a high quality club. The toughest part is finding the one that is right for you. The best way to do that is by picking out a couple of brands or club head styles that you might be interested in or that are appealing to your eye and take them to the driving range. And I mean a real driving

range, not a net or a computer screen or any thing like that. It is very important that you see the ball fly through the air so you can get feed back from the feel of the club, the sound that it makes and the way that the ball travels through the air. To properly fit a person usually takes from 20 minutes to an hour, depending on the individual and whether they have one specific club in mind or are trying to choose from several, plus most companies ship within a few days of the order so you won't have to wait very long to get your club in your hands and on the course. Also remember that as a member of The Briarwood you get a discount in the Pro Shop and your price is usually lower than what you can find in town or on the internet.

As I write this, 15 Briarwood members and I are getting ready to head south to Mesquite and Las Vegas for a little fun in the sun and the 2-man Battle in the Desert! I will up date everyone in the March Chip Shot but I'm pretty sure that we are going to have a great time. If you didn't get to go this year, don't worry because I'm sure we will do this again next year. I've already had suggestions for Phoenix and South Carolina so look for upcoming trips as the year goes on.

News from the MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

Like everyone, we are anxiously waiting for Spring. The recently melted snow has revealed that the course is in great shape going into Spring. We had snow cover at the right times, which protected the grass from the extreme cold temps. The snow cover also reduced any wear and tear to the course from winter play. I am confident you will see better conditions on the course, during the Spring and Summer. Other than the weather, here is what's been happening in the maintenance department and what is in store for the near future.

Pump Station: During the winter, the plans for the removal of the pump station were finalized. Funding has been arranged and the plans for the pumps are being drawn up. Once the drawings are approved and signed, the pumps will be fabricated. It will take approximately six weeks to fabricate and deliver the pumps and controls. We will then build a new building around the pumps.

Tree work: Some dead trees have been removed from around the course. The removed trees were potentially dangerous

because of their location. Some were next to greens and some were leaning over cart paths. We have and are still working on tree trimming and some cleanup from high winds. The course appearance and safety is improved with this practice.

Bunkers: We are scheduled to have the bunker work completed by the end of April. This includes the drainage work at #4 and #16, new bunker rakes for the entire course, and adding a finer coal slag particle to adjust the playability of the bunkers.

#4 Bridge: The bridge at #4 will have some repairs made to it. The truck that services the "blue plastic toilet" at #4 causes damage to the bridge. The Greens

Committee has discussed options for that toilet. We would like to eliminate the service truck traffic resulting in better turf conditions and visual presentation of hole #4. If anyone has any ideas concerning the placement or management of that toilet, please let Katie or myself know.

Irrigation Work: Work on the irrigation system is scheduled to resume in March. Now that the snow has melted and the temperatures are starting to increase we can begin to renovate the irrigation system at #4.

You will be enjoying golf soon. We look forward to seeing you on the course in the next few weeks.
