## News from the MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

As we proceed into the Fall, remember to expect frost delays in the mornings. The elevation change between Billings and the Briarwood Subdivision means that there is an 8-9 degree temperature difference. Also, remember the coldest part of the day is in the first half hour after sunrise. If you live in Billings and are rushing out to play at Briarwood, first thing in the morning, you might want to consider stopping at McDonalds first and let things warm up a bit. Also of note, the frost on the practice facility is the same as the frost on the golf course. Walking on or playing from frosted grass surfaces will injure the grass.

Another wonderful event during Fall is the dropping of the leaves from the hardwood trees. With the size of

our crew and the number of large cottonwood trees on the front nine, expect to have times when the leaves are in the way. We understand that it is frustrating to hit a good shot only to lose the ball somewhere in a pile of leaves. It is frustrating for us, also, to have just cleared a green, fairway, or tee then have the wind pick up and deposit more leaves. I am sure you as golfers/members would not like the option that is available to rid the course of leaf problems, unless you have a wood burning stove.

Speaking of cutting down trees, we are in the process of removing the dead pines that were killed as a result of mountain pine beetle attacks. We do this as a preventative measure so as to reduce the possibilities of future attacks, and reduce the numbers of

secondary and tertiary beetles that come in after the tree is dead. Dead standing pine trees are a liability both to golfers and to the forest. So when I thin out the dead trees I am doing so with the golfers' safety in mind and the overall health of the forest under my protection. In other words, I just don't cut down trees to upset the members. Tree felling and removal is hard work and I have enough work as it is.

The golf course is in good shape coming off the course aeration and has healed up nicely. Come out and enjoy the course and cooler temperatures. Just remember to fix your ball marks, fix your divots, and scatter. Any damage done to the greens and the rest of the course will be around until next April.

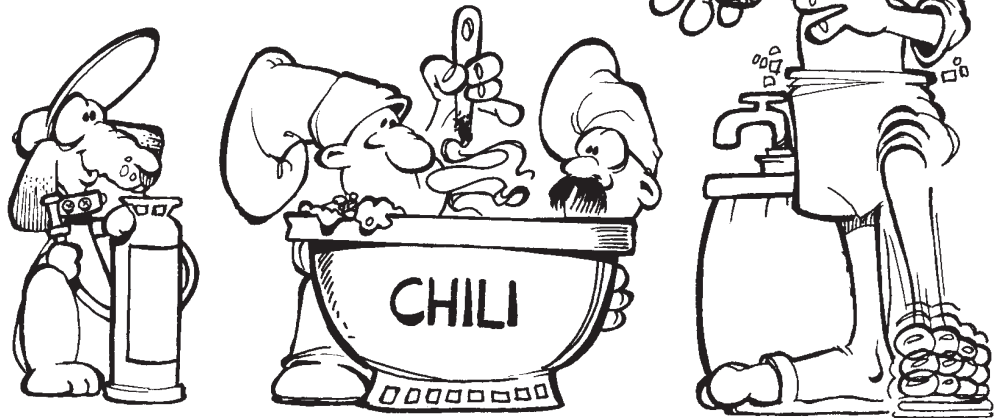
